Aristocrat Leisure Limited (ASX: ALL) today announced the commencement of further legal proceedings against competitors for patent infringement.

Aristocrat is continuing a strategy to aggressively defend its intellectual property rights against infringement, as outlined in the company's recent half-year results announcement.

In the last 12 months Aristocrat has successfully taken action against Independent Gaming Pty Ltd and Konami Australia Pty Ltd in Australia for infringement of its intellectual property.

Aristocrat also has separate proceedings underway in the Federal Court of Australia against IGT (Australia) Pty Ltd and Konami Australia Pty Ltd.

The company today commenced proceedings against Ainsworth Game Technology (ASX: AGI) for infringement of a range of Aristocrat patents.
